## **NOTICE OF REQUESTED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION**

Subject: Incidental Take of Northern Spotted Owl (*Strix occidentalis caurina*)  
During Candidacy Period.

The California Forestry Association (Calforests) is requesting the Commission take emergency rulemaking action under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) and Fish and Game Code section 240 to adopt, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 2084, a rule authorizing incidental take of Northern Spotted Owls (*Strix occidentalis caurina*) while the species is a candidate for listing.

Attached to this notice is the specific regulatory language of Calforest's proposed emergency action and Finding of Emergency as required by the APA.

The Commission is scheduled to consider the adoption of the proposed emergency regulation at its December 11, 2013 meeting. Any person interested may present statements, orally or in writing, relevant to this action at a hearing to be held in the Hilton San Diego Mission Valley, 901 Camino del Rio South, San Diego, California, on Wednesday, December 11, 2013 at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

If adopted by the Commission, it is anticipated that the emergency regulation will be filed with the Office of Administrative Law on or about December [REDACTED], 2013.
