As you've likely heard, Virginia died unexpectedly of natural causes on March 20, the first day of Spring (as did her late husband, Dr. Norman Seaton, in 2009), leaving our entire movement in a state of shock and sadness.

In my opinion, Virginia was THE very best and most knowledgeable animal advocate EVER, and a walking encyclopedia of California legislation pertaining to animal welfare legislation for some 40 years. Many California laws now on the books are a result of her tireless efforts over the years. She was also mentor and dear friend for three-plus decades. We'll not see her likes again.

Former STATE ASSEMBLYMAN BOB CAMPBELL (Paw PAC's "Assemblymember of the Year," 1987) has agreed to speak at the memorial, and other legislators have been invited to speak as well. Time will be allotted for other attendees to speak briefly, if so inclined. We'll be showing a short TV interview with Virginia done in 2009.
