Hi, I met director Sonke Mastrup at the Monterey commission meeting in August. He was asking for ideas about how to roll out the lead ban. I have been thinking about the best approach.

If the goal is to reduce lead exposure as much as possible the place to start would be the types of hunting that leave the most lead in the environment. This would be varmint and predator hunting and pig hunting. I understand non-lead 22lr ammo is hard to get, and not as effective as lead. For small game like squirrels the latest generation of air rifles could be a substitute with non-lead pellets. For center fire there is no major issue, good quality non-lead ammo is available.

This would reduce the lead entering the environment the most.
