Subject: Proposed Klamath River fishing closure at Blue Cree,

Fish and Wildlife,

Please remember that the Klamath is a navigable water way. The purpose of the commission is to improve and provide for fishing for all of our state residents, native and others. Non native people are entitled to fifty percent of the proposed take just as are native people under the second Boldt decision. Let's wait until all of the stakeholders including Karok and Klamath people are part of this discussion. Do not close the Blue Creek area to fishing by non native people.

Closing this fishery would also hurt the Yurok tribe. They provide fuel, gaming and have just purchased Steelhead Lodge. Closing the fishery at Blue Creek will create animosity and most certainly hurt the tribes interests.
