Hey, that's really nice of them to propose catch and release restrictions on members of the Tribe; the part that's not to clear is, nothing caught in the Tribal members drift nets gets released!!! and how many tribal members fish with a rod and reel? Are they going to propose less netting days? Shorter hours/ day? A reduced season on Commercial gill netting? Just because the Tribe didn't get their "fair" quota of fish last season, because someone miscalculated the amount of the run, doesn't mean you (DFW) have to make up for it this year.

I understand the concern about catch and release and mortality rates in warm water, but to blame the fishermen , who have no control over the water releases from the Trinity-which cools down the lower Klamath, doesn't seem quite fair, nor equitable. May I suggest a catch and release tagging study, which would at least give DFW an estimate of the survival rate of these caught and released fish.
