Subsection 300(a)(1)(G), Title 14, CCR is amended as follows:

<i>Species</i>	<i>1. Seasons</i>	<i>2. Daily Bag and Possession Limits</i>
<b>(G) Wild Turkeys</b>	a. <b>Fall Season</b> - The second Saturday in November extending for 16 consecutive days	Bag Limit: 1 either-sex turkey per day, 1 per season  Possession Limit: 1 per season
	a. <b>Spring Season</b> - The last Saturday in March extending for 37 consecutive days  b. <b>Additional Spring Season for Hunters with Junior Hunting Licenses</b> – <u>The Saturday and Sunday preceding the opening day of the general spring turkey season; and t</u> The day following the close of the general spring turkey season extending for 14 consecutive days	Bag Limit: 1 bearded turkey per day, 3 per season. No person shall take more than a total of 3 turkeys during the general, archery, and additional season for junior hunters, combined.  Possession Limit: 3 per season  (A bearded turkey is one having a beard visible through the breast feathers.)
3. Area: Statewide including State Game Refuge 1G, located in Tehama County
