For instance, the Department's Fisheries Branch is the lead in preparing the regulatory documents for the Klamath River sport fishing regulations. At the February meeting, the Commission will receive the Department's recommendations (and public recommendations, if any) and will authorize staff to publish a notice of its intent to amend the regulations. (Staff will publish and mail the notice on February 22.) At the March meeting, the Department may provide a short presentation on the proposed regulations and the public may comment on the proposed regulations. At the April meeting, after hearing the Department's presentation and any additional public comments, the Commission may adopt the regulations.
