

## REGULATORY TEXT

### KEY:

Section 180.6, Title 14, CCR, is amended to read:

(a) All openings in traps used to take hagfish, excluding the entrance funnel, shall have a minimum diameter of 9/16 inch in any dimension.

(b) Hagfish may be taken in 40-gallon barrel traps, if attached to a central ground line. No more than a total of 25 barrel traps may be possessed aboard a vessel or in the water or combination thereof. Barrels may be attached to a maximum of ~~two~~three ground lines. If using barrel traps, no other trap type may be used or possessed aboard the vessel. Poppers shall not be used on buoy lines attached to barrel traps.
